Gajendra Singh Shekhawat, Union Minister of Tourism & Culture, graced the occasion with his presence and congratulated DDP Group for honouring excellence and said, "Tourism is not just

He further said, "We have also encouraged every state to develop at least one destination to global standards, creating new circuits and spreading benefits across the nation. Tourism today must be sustainable and responsible as they are not a choice, but the foundation of tomorrow. India's commitment to Mission LiFE ensures that travel becomes a force for protecting the environment, conserving heritage, wildlife and empowering communities." He added that tourism is not just for food and health. It fuels the craft, guides, transport and countless local enterprises and craftsmen. Hence, we are also focusing on skill development and investing in opportunities.

Suman Billa, Additional Secretary & Director General, Ministry of Tourism, Gol in his keynote address, highlighted tourism's vital role in national develing travel destination, he said, "India's

tourism growth is inevitable — the true challenge lies in how we grow. To achieve our vision of becoming a \$3 trillion tourism economy by 2047, we must focus not just on numbers, but on excellence and quality that make India a proud global service leader."

Giving advice to young professionals, Billa, stated, "Tourism in India is at the beginning of a long-term growth cycle, offering immense opportunities. Young professionals should look beyond jobs in hospitality and explore entrepreneurship, as we are under-leveraged in tourism products and experiences — areas where young innovators can create meaningful offerings and showcase them to the world.

Speaking on the recent GST reform, he noted that GST has been beneficial for the industry. With tax rates reduced from 12% to 5%, consumers are enjoying significant savings. While there are minor issues around input tax credit that need to be addressed with the GST Council, the overall direction is positive and supports the sector's growth.

A highlight of the evening was the unveiling of a coffee table book chronicling the industry's resilience and commitment to sustainability, inclusivity and innovation. The event was graced by eminent leaders including Ashwani Lohani, Director, Prime Ministers' Museum & Library and Lindy Cameron, British High Commissioner to India, reinforcing the importance of government-industry collaboration.

Addressing the gathering, Lohani highlighted that sustainability is not optional — it is essential to preserve our destinations. He said, "India's true strength lies in domestic tourism. With our economy growing and our heritage so rich, we must first explore and appreciate our own diverse land — one nation, many worlds." ITA inspires tourism players, and their motivation fuels India's tourism growth. If we handle tourism wisely, its potential can truly reach the skies, he added.

Speaking at the event, SanJeet, Mentor, India Travel Awards, said, "The awards honour pioneers redefining tourism — blending culture, technology and community. Together, they show how travel can be a force for inclusive growth, cross-cultural understanding and a future where journeys touch lives, not just destinations."

The gala concluded with a sit-down dinner and networking, reaffirming the India Travel Awards as the industry's most credible platform for excellence.
